## Overdue Notices

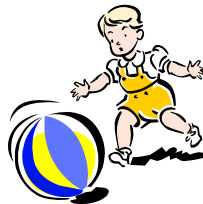

Celebrate National Library Week at WPL!

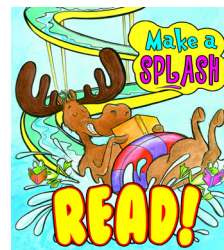
