Further Budget Cuts

A funding cut of 5% for both the 2012 and 2013 fiscal budgets is proposed for Ohio libraries. In addition to the previous cut of 30%, our funding would be at 1996 levels. This especially hits hard those libraries, such as Wayne Public Library, that don't have operating levies and receive nearly all of their funding from the State. We will continue to do our best with the funds we receive to provide quality materials and services to our patrons. Now more than ever, donations are greatly appreciated!
